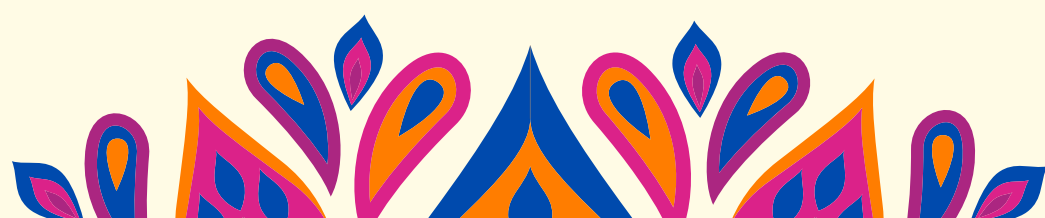

Mrs. Geetha Mohanram Bio:

Geetha was born into a family of devotees who first recognized Swami's divinity in 1943; since then, 5 generations of her family have remained at His Lotus Feet. Her father Dr. Padmanabhan, a renowned dental surgeon, served Swami in various organizational capacities for decades, and is well-known as the person who walked behind Swami during darshan in Whitefield. Geetha's mother Kamala Padmanabhan, part of the original group that developed the first Bal Vikas curriculum under the direction of Bhagawan Himself, was subsequently appointed by Swami to be the SSE coordinator for Karnataka state in India, a post in which she served with distinction for 25 years.

Geetha has had the incredible fortune of growing up in the shadow of our Divine Lord since birth, enjoying and experiencing His divinity and multi-faceted personality during His frequent visits to their family home and the family's lengthy visits to His ashrams. At the tender age of 15, Geetha was selected by Swami to be an SSE teacher and to deliver lectures under the EHV (Education in Human Values) program to high school teachers throughout the state of Karnataka, India. She had the rare privilege of serving as Swami's scribe during the formalization of the Bal Vikas curriculum, writing down the nectarine directions and words of Bhagawan Himself as He developed this program.

In 1978, her marriage to Mohan Ram was performed in the Divine Presence of Swami at Whitefield. After emigrating to the U.S. in 1987 at Swami's direction, she and Mohan Ram, along with their twin sons Varun and Arun, settled in Laurel, Maryland, where they still live, now delighting in the company of 4 grand-children. Geetha was an award-winning kindergarten teacher for 22 years and has served as SSE Coordinator and Vice-President of the Sri Sathya Sai South Bethesda Center. Over the past 25 years, at Swami's command and with His blessings, Geetha has been sharing her treasured experiences with our beloved Lord with devotees all over the world. She is a gifted and highly sought-after speaker, able to transport her audience to another place and time to share in each of her experiences with our beloved Lord.
